

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

- After the successful completion of the examinations, the prospective pilot must send an email to exams@hcaa.gov.gr to request their overall analytical score.

Examination Procedure & Courses

- **Question:** Examination participation procedure.
- **Answer:** Participation in the examinations (and the booking process) first requires the submission of a relevant application by the candidate's School.
- **Question:** Is it possible to take an exam for a different course than the one booked?
- **Answer:** Course selection is possible up to one (1) hour prior to the examination. After this deadline, the declared course is "locked" by the Electronic Examination System, and no change is permitted.
- **Question:** Is a change in the examination order of two (2) courses booked for the same day permitted?
- **Answer:** The order selection is possible up to one (1) hour prior to the examination. After this deadline, the declared course is "locked," and no change is permitted.
- **Question:** Is the re-examination of a failed course permitted within the same examination period (sitting)?
- **Answer:** No. According to the Examination Regulation, re-examination of the same course is not permitted within the same examination period.
- **Question:** Is it possible to participate in the examination at a different time than the scheduled booking?
- **Answer:** Candidates must arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the examination start time. If the scheduled arrival time is exceeded, participation in the examination is not possible. Beyond the 30-minute limit, late arrival may be rejected at the discretion of the HCAA Examination Centre team.

Candidate Identification

- **Question:** Can the examinee's identification be performed using their Residence Permit?
- **Answer:** No. Identification can only be performed using the candidate's Identity Card or Passport.
- **Question:** What actions are required by the examinee in case of a change in their passport or identity card for identification purposes?

- **Answer:** The examinee must immediately inform their School. The School will declare the new identification details when registering for the upcoming examination period, and the HCAA will update the candidate's Account accordingly.

Examination Results

- **Question:** How can the examinees be informed of their examination result?
- **Answer:** The result is immediately displayed on the examinee's account in the Seat Booking Management System. The results are available under the "**Candidate Information**" option of the account.
- **Question:** Is it necessary to wait for a message containing the result after the examination has been concluded?
- **Answer:** No. The result is immediately available in the examinee's account.
- **Question:** How does the prospective pilot request the overall analytical score after the successful completion of the examinations?
- **Answer:** The candidate must send an email to exams@hcaa.gov.gr to request their overall analytical score.
